

Take Me Out Tickets Braves Opening Day Sweepstakes

OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.

The Take Me Out Tickets Braves Opening Day Sweepstakes (“Opening Day Sweepstakes”) is sponsored by Take Me Out Tickets, 923 3rd Avenue, Decatur, GA 30030 (hereinafter referred to as “sponsor”). The Opening Day Sweepstakes is governed by these official rules. By participating in the Opening Day Sweepstakes, each entrant agrees to these official rules, including eligibility requirements. The Opening Day Sweepstakes is subject to all federal, state, and municipal laws and is void where prohibited by law.

Eligibility

The Opening Day Sweepstakes is open to legal residents of the United States, who must also be 18 years of age and older as of March 24, 2008. Employees, officers and directors of Take Me Out Tickets and their immediate family members (defined as spouse, mother, father, in-laws, grandmother, grandfather, brother, sister, children and grandchildren) are not eligible to win.

Entry

The Opening Day Sweepstakes begins at 12:01 am on March 5, 2008 and ends at 11:59:59 p.m. on March 23, 2008 (Opening Day Sweepstakes period). To enter the Opening Day Sweepstakes, entrants must complete an online entry form found at www.takemeoutonline.com.

Only one (1) entry per customer. The Sponsor is not responsible for electronic network, scanner or computer hardware or software malfunction and /or transmission failure, loss or delayed or corrupted, data transmissions, or any technical or human error that may occur in the transmission, receipt or processing of entries or difficulties of any kind.

Prize

The Opening Day Sweepstakes prize will be two field level tickets for one winner and his/her guest to see the Atlanta Braves vs. Pittsburgh Pirates on March 31, 2008 in Atlanta, Georgia.

ALL EXPENSES, TAXES, AND COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH ACCEPTANCE OF THE PRIZE ARE THE OBLIGATION OF THE WINNER. PRIZE IS AWARDED WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND BY SPONSOR, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, WITHOUT LIMITATION.

Sponsor reserves the right to award a prize of equal or greater value or make other reasonable accommodations in the event of unavailability of the stated prize.

Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

Drawing

The Opening Day Sweepstakes drawing will be held March 24, 2008. Only entries received before the end of the Opening Day Sweepstakes period will be eligible.

The prize winner will be selected in a random drawing from among all eligible entries received during the Braves Opening Day Sweepstakes period. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

The winner will be notified at the phone number, address, and / or e-mail address submitted with the entry. If the selected winner fails to contact sponsor to claim the prize **within 48 hours** of the sending or posting of notification, or if the selected winner cannot be located through reasonable, good-faith efforts by the sponsor, an alternative winner may be selected from among the remaining eligible entries.

If by reason of a printing, computer, production, or other error, more than one winning entry is claimed, all persons making purportedly valid claims will be included in a random drawing to award the prize. In the event this Sweepstakes is compromised or becomes technically corrupted in any way, electronically or otherwise, the Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, terminate, or suspend the Sweepstakes and in such event, to select winner for the prize by random drawing from among all valid entries received, up to such time of cancellation, termination or suspension. Entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the judges.

Publicity
